

Pin Configuration (Top View)




1: ANODE 3: CATHODE






Test Circuit 1: Switching Time Test Circuit






Test Circuit 2: Common Mode Transient Immunity Test Circuit








Figure 1 Device Orientation




Figure 2 Tape Forms




Figure 3 Reel Form


